- ACADEMIC ACTIVITIES

QUIZZOCIATES CLASS

Every second and fourth Saturday, General Knowledge coaching classes are conducted for students of Classes VI to VIII by "**The Quizzociates**," an organization run by retired bank professionals. Students who have shown interest and registered for the programme regularly attend these sessions. The coaching classes are being held at our school Library.

A total of **27 students** have enrolled in this academic year 2026-27. The primary objective of the programme is to inculcate the habit of reading and to enhance students' general awareness, current affairs knowledge, and quizzing skills. Through these interactive sessions, students are encouraged to develop curiosity, improve their knowledge base, and build confidence in participating in various quiz competitions.



SMART QUIZ

To foster a spirit of learning and encourage students to stay updated with current affairs and general knowledge, the school conducts the **SMART QUIZ** programme through the library.

Every school day, **five General Knowledge questions** are displayed on the Library Display Board. Students write and submit their answers during the break periods. The student who submits the **first** entry with the **maximum number of correct answers** is declared the winner of the day.

The winners are honoured during the school assembly, motivating students to participate enthusiastically and develop the habit of reading newspapers, magazines, and other informative resources. The programme aims to enhance students' general awareness, quick thinking, and competitive spirit while promoting regular use of the school library.



SIP ARITHMETIC TEST – 01.07.2026

The SIP Arithmetic Group successfully conducted the SIP Arithmetic Test on 1st July 2026 for students of Classes I to V. The young participants took part with great enthusiasm and showcased their arithmetic skills with confidence.

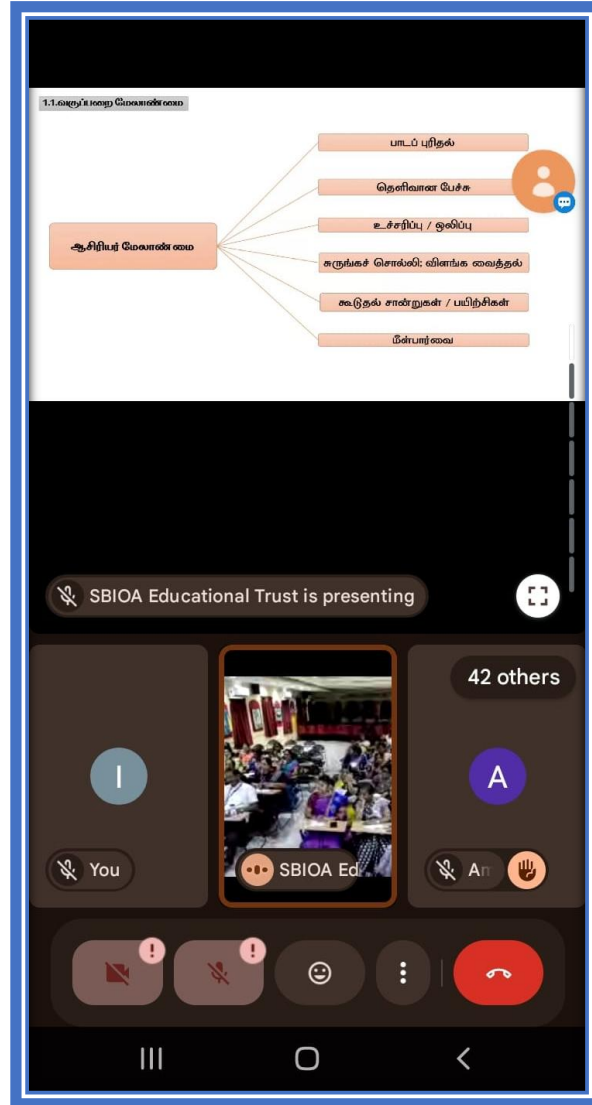

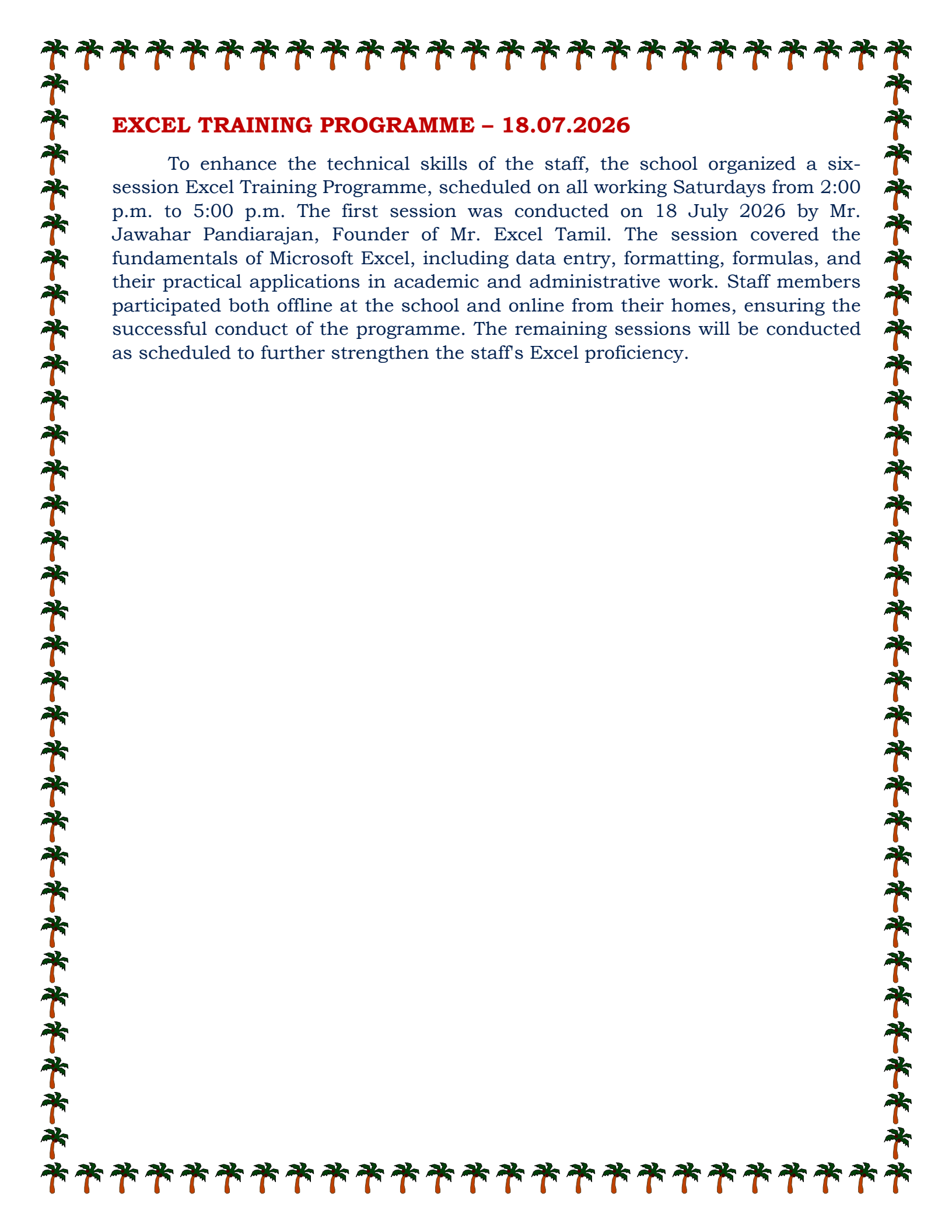


SEMINAR FOR TEACHERS
